- Walk to the National Mall to view the proceedings from there. No tickets are required and the Mall will be lined with JumboTron TV screens so you can watch the proceedings. Though you will be more distant from the platform than those with tickets, you will still be part of the action – part of history! The vibe on the Mall will be positively electric so consider this a reasonable alternative for non-ticket participation.
- View the swearing-in from Rep. Sam Farr's hospitality suite. This will be a room near the Capitol that will have a big screen TV, snacks and drinks and be warm and close to restrooms!
