

WASHINGTON, D.C. - Congressman Sam Farr (D-Carmel) on Tuesday attended the signing ceremony for the health insurance reform bill. He released the following statement after the ceremony:

"The last two days have been so exciting, first voting for this health insurance overhaul and today watching the president sign the bill. It was a proud day for me and for all of my colleagues who joined me in supporting this legislation.
